Our students Master Sharvaj Fulgaonkar scored 98.2% with 100 out of 100 in Sanskrit, 99 in Mathematics, Sharvari Chaudhary scored 97.4% with 100 out of 100 in Sanskrit, Aastha Desai scored 95.4%.
