**The school academic year started on 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2024. The Gregorian Public School is proud to acknowledge that, we secured 100% result for the academic year 2023-24. For Std X in CBSE Board exams.**

**Total 93 students appeared for board examination in which 9 achieved above 90%, 21 passed with distinction, 35 first class and 28 second class.**

**Our Students Ms. Arya Bade scored 97% with 100/100 in Sanskrit, 99 in Science, 97 in Mathematics, Ms. Sharvi Arekar scored 95% and Prisha Jain scored 94.6%.**

**Five Students Ms. Arya Bade, Ms.Prisha Jain, Ms.Jui Mali, Master Atharva Varkhale and Master Shivam Pal scored 100/100 in Sanskrit.**
